We have been showing our **'Empathy and Listening'** learning behaviour by waiting for our turn to talk.






2HM




In 1CC we chose to copy good behaviours of others using our **imitation** learning behaviour. We had to copy our partner in this activity to understand what imitation was.





RTE used **Empathy** and **Listening**


learning behaviour to understand why bullying was wrong. We also used our listening skill during our science Dome visit.
